NOTICE OF RACE

2011 KALAKAUA CUP REGATTA

Saturday, July 2, Dillingham Race-Waikiki to Kaneohe

Sunday, July 3, Two Kaneohe Offshore Races

Monday, July 4, Kanewai Race-Kaneohe to Waikiki

1. RULES: The races will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and US SAILING prescriptions with 2010 amendments, and the ISAF Special Regulations for Category 4 Races with US Sailing modifications. Kaneohe Yacht Club (KYC) is the organizing authority.

2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY and FEES: The races are open to monohull keel boats owned or chartered by members of HYRA clubs possessing a valid HPHRF handicap. Other boats may be invited by the organizing authority. Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and submitting it with the required fee to KYC prior to 1830 Wednesday, June 29. The entry fee for all four races is \$60.00 (\$50.00 for US Sailing members). The daily entry fee is \$30.00 (or \$25.00 for US Sailing members). Boats may be entered separately for the Kaneohe Offshore or Kanewai races by submitting an entry form and the applicable fee to KYC prior to 0900 on Sunday, July 3.

3. CLASSES: PHRF A and B, and PH Cruising (PHC). A Minimum of three (3) entries by 1830 June 29 will be required to establish a class.

4. SCHEDULE of EVENTS:

If a PHC class is established, it will start first and the warning for the combined PHRF classes will be five minutes later. The warning for Kaneohe Offshore race 2 will be a few minutes after the last finish of race 1.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The sailing instructions will be available at the Kaneohe and Waikiki Yacht Clubs, on the KYC website (kaneoheyachtclub.com), or by email on or after June 29.

6. VENUE and COURSES: The courses will be on the coastal waters of Oahu. Refer to the Sailing instructions for each day's race.

7. SCORING:

7.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4.1 will apply, except that no race scores will be excluded. This modifies Rule A2.

7.2 All races will be included in the HYRA Oahu Season's Points Scoring.

8. BERTHING: To facilitate mooring arrangements at KYC visiting boats must provide LOA, beam and draft data on their entry form. Contact the KYC Port Captain, Bob Hurd, at 291-7001 to discuss mooring arrangements.

9. PRIZES: Daily prizes for first place in each class will be presented that day if possible. The Kalakaua Cup perpetual trophy will be awarded to the overall PHRF winner and officially presented at the 2011 HYRA Annual Awards Dinner.
