NOTICE OF RACE

2013 Hawaii State Keelboat Championship Regatta

October 26 & 27, 2013

- 1. RULES:** This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) with US SAILING prescriptions, and the Cal 20 class rules, except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions. Each boat must have a unique sail number on both sides of the mainsail. The organizing authority is Kaneohe Yacht Club.
- 2. ADVERTISING:** Shall be limited to sailmaker's marks.
- 3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY:**
 - 3.1** The regatta is open to Cal 20 sloops owned or chartered by clubs or members of clubs affiliated with the Hawaii Yacht Racing Association (HYRA). The skipper shall be a dues-paying or life member in good standing of an HYRA affiliated club (or the spouse or minor child of such a member) and must be the helmsman at all times except in an emergency.
 - 3.2** Eligible owners or skippers may enter by completing and submitting the attached race entry form with the entry fee to KYC no later than 1000 the morning of the first race day..
- 4. FEES:** The entry fees will be \$25.00 for US Sailing members and \$15.00 for junior skippers under age 18. For all others the fee will be \$30.00. Make checks payable to Kaneohe YC.
- 5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:**

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The warning signal for subsequent races will follow the finish of the prior race within 10 minutes except for a 15-20 minute break after two races. There will be a maximum of eight races in the regatta.

6. **HAULOUTS:** All boats shall remain in the water at the KYC bulkhead on Saturday night, September 29. Exceptions may be granted by the PRO in the case of damage that requires a haulout for repairs.
7. **MEASUREMENT:** Boat must be have been weighted during 2013 to compete in the regatta. Sails must be measured (any year acceptable). Boats / sails that have not been measured within this time frame should contact the fleet measurer.
8. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The Sailing Instructions for this event will be on the KYC website and will be available at the Skippers' Meeting.
9. **VENUE and COURSES:** The venue will be Kaneohe Bay between Moku O'Loe (Coconut Island) and KYC. The courses will be will be displayed by the Race Committee at or prior to the warning for each race as described in the Sailing Instructions.
10. **SCORING:** The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply. A minimum of three races must be completed to constitute a series. If more than three races are completed, one race will be discarded from each boat's series score. This modifies Rule A2.
11. **PRIZES:** Winners will be announced at the end of the regatta. Take-home prizes will be awarded for first through third place. The Perpetual Trophy will be awarded at the HYRA annual banquet.
